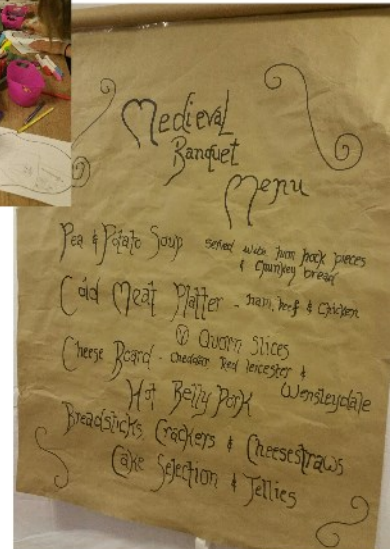


Medieval Sleep over
